Ms. Sally has also been part of the professional performing company at The Boston Ballet Company and the former Dallas Ballet Company, now Texas Ballet Theater. She continues to share her passion for dance with aspiring students at her studio in Richardson, Texas.

CLASSES

RETURNING: Toby's **SWAG COMPANY!**

A fun dance company for ages 6-10!

COMBINATION OR COMBO CLASSES for ages 3-7 introduce the fundamentals of dance. These classes include ballet, tap and tumbling for younger dancers, and ballet, tap and jazz for older dancers.

BALLET is the basic foundation for all other styles of dance and should be studied first or in combination with other dance forms. Formal ballet training typically begins at the age of 7. Ballet students perform in a full-length ballet as their end-of-the-year recital production. Past ballets include Coppelia, Aurora's Wedding, and The Secret Garden.

TAP is FUN for EVERYONE! It is a rapid way for dancers (from child to adult) to "feel" the rhythmic beat, develop coordination and translate these skills into an energizing dance movement.

JAZZ is unrestricted, non-classical and less academic than ballet. Most students have a background in both ballet and tap prior to beginning jazz classes.

MODERN is a more free-form dance style. Fundamental modern techniques are intertwined with the dancer's own interpretation of emotion and expression. Students must master the basics of Intermediate Ballet before beginning modern.

LYRICAL/CONTEMPORARY is a combination of ballet, modern and jazz techniques presented with modern or pop music. Students must master the basics of Intermediate Ballet before beginning lyrical/contemporary.

ADULT CLASSES OFFERED: all levels of tap, ballet, and jazz.

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
